

Dear Parent/ Carers

The pupils break up for the Summer holidays today and we are really pleased that so many of our pupils have worked so hard over the past year. Over the last few weeks many of them have also been having transition sessions with their new teachers, and I am sure this will support them in settling back into their learning in September.

Pupils who will be in class-based groups in September are aware of who they will be with next year and our older pupils were informed today who their tutor will be in September. I am currently finalising the class timetables and any individual pupil timetables, and these will be sent out to all pupils before September.

We have a number of new pupils who have joined us over the past 8 weeks, and we will be hoping to have an individual pupil review meeting with all our new pupils at the start of the next school year. We will contact parents/carers separately about this.

We have just completed end of year achievement reports for our pupils, and these are being sent home with pupils today. We hope that pupils will take note of any 'next steps' identified by staff on their report, to support them in having a positive start back to school in September.

School re-opens for pupils, including residential pupils on Tuesday 5th September. The start of the school day is 8.35am and school day finishes at 3.15pm when it moves into the Extended Day. In September Extended Day will continue to end at 5pm but we are planning for this to be extended to 7pm before October half term. I will inform you of any changes when the necessary arrangements have been made.
